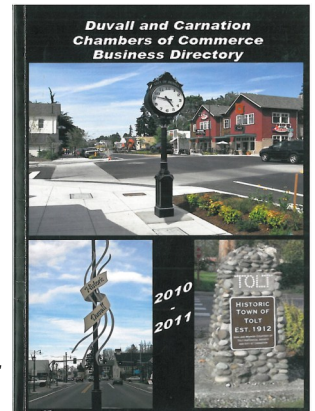

Duvall Historical Society Meeting

The public is invited to a public meeting of the Duvall Historical Society at The Depot on Monday, October 3 at 7:30 pm, where Ray Burhen will give a free presentation on early day logging in Cherry Valley (now Duvall).

Historical slides and pictures will help show various types of equipment used in logging and transport of logs. Ray will describe the evolution of the big changes in logging machinery and techniques from the early 20th century to the present. These changes were reflected in changes in marketing of timber, its availability, and the evolution of the different types of sawmills.

Ray has lived in the Snoqualmie Valley for sixty-five years and knew many of the early loggers. He ran a saw mill in the mid-20th century and owns a small plot of timberland. Ray has witnessed these changes first hand and has some fascinating stories to tell about a very interesting time in our history.
